

Gift Aid declaration

for past, present & future donations



Gift Aid means that if you are a UK taxpayer we can reclaim 25 pence of tax on every £1 you donate to Churchcentral. In order for us to claim you need to complete a Gift Aid declaration. Please read the notes below before completing the declaration form. Please note that the details must be completed for an individual not a couple. If you give as a couple and both are UK taxpayers, please complete separate declaration forms and confirm how we are to assign your giving and gift aid eg. 50/50.

You must notify us if you want to cancel this declaration, change your name or home address, or no longer pay sufficient tax on your income/or capital gains.

If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.

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Please treat as Gift Aid donations all qualifying gifts of money made:

I confirm I have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (from 6 April to 5 April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax which Churchcentral, and all other charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs, will reclaim on my donations.

I understand that other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify. I understand the charity will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that I give.
